Introduction

Like other yearbooks this one is also a compendium of information and a selection of articles. The information is based on that available on my Chingland site, consisting of maps, lists of clubs and weblinks. I have also included a number of league tables for the 2010/11 season. Chess and bridge - About the author.

Ignoring a couple of matches I got roped into at University - the chess and bridge clubs shared a room - I've been playing competitive chess for about 30 years, the first half of which overlapped with the latter part of my bridge career. Despite playing only 60 games last season I regard myself as an 80 games a year man, including eight to 10 congresses. Coming from bridge I am still amazed by how little chess the typical chess player plays - 100 session a year bridge players are commonplace.

I firmly believe that the club captains, league controllers and congress organisers who between them give the rest of us a chance to play the wonderful game are the good guys, no matter how frustrating some of them can be on a personal level. Indeed to me the biggest failing of the ECF is its steadfast refusal to get involved in organising chess events. How else can they lose the tag of being a body that allows others to organise their own chess, and then charges for the privilege?

In accordance with my beliefs I captain a club team, hold a position on the league committee, and do a little small scale organising for the benefit of club members and those who live nearby.

Profit from Profits

In a posting about an e2e4 event he had run in Ireland Sean Hewitt noted that several players there had said that they hoped he had made a profit, a response that he had not experienced when holding events in England. Hopefully it is just a case of English reticence, for I know that many of those who are willing to talk to me on the congress circuit believe that organisers should be able to make a profit from their operations. On the other hand I have to admit that I do not naturally gravitate towards those happy to play in venues where a single 60W lamp does dual service as source of light and heat.

Players gain from organisers making profits. Profits accruing to individuals must have at least a marginal motivating effect on them, encouraging them to put on events in the future. Gains made by organisations provide reserves that can be called on in future to protect their congress against changes in entries and overheads. Profits for established events also make it easier for new ones to be created at the same general price to entrants.

If you like playing chess, then profits for organisers are good for you - they make it more likely that there will be events out there for you to play in.

Board Order Shenanigans

Exville whose players in order of strength are Amir, Baz, Chas and Daz play Wyeton whose players in the same order are Jon, Kamil, Len and Mary. Amir plays Jon, Baz plays Len, Chas plays Kamil and Daz plays Mary.

"Objection!" cries Mr Stickler. "Wyeton have gained an unfair advantage by playing out of order. Fine them. Deduct points. Hang 'em."

Casual Carl, from his usual horizontal position, fails to get excited: "Does it matter?"

"Of course it matters. We must do things properly. ..."

Zzzzzzzzzz.

Most of us will have witnessed or heard of events of this type, and will feel a natural sympathy for either Mr Stickler or Casual Carl.

Time to confess. I've been a little economical with the truth. The pairings were indeed as given, but the card shows in board order Amir v Jon, Chas v Kamil, Baz v Len, Daz v Mary. I reported the pairings from Exvilles point of view; it is their playing out of order that led to the "incorrect" pairings. Mr Stickler immediately switches to jumping on Exville, demanding that they be punished for gaining an unfair advantage through playing out of order.

Clearly the same pairings cannot lead to an advantage to either team depending purely on which side placed their middle boards the wrong way round. In general any advantage gained from playing a strong player on too low a board will be balanced by the disadvantage of playing a weaker player on too high a board. This breaks down though if the weaker players chances aren't diminished by promoting him. Board order rules that guard against the use of sacrificial lambs - players whose promotion merely reduces their chances from negligible to non-existent - may be sensible, those relating to the order of near equals are mere control-freakery.

Grading can make you give up chess

Hearing discussions on or finding articles about grading is commonplace, but do they concentrate on what matters?

The difference between the Elo and Clarke expected results functions is no big deal. Indeed, suppose you process a set of your results to get a new grade. If your opponents grades form a symmetrical set about your own, then any expected results function f satisfying $f(d) + f(-d) = 1$ where d is the difference in grades will give the same answer.

Ever agreed a draw in a won position because of circumstances external to the game (it secures a congress prize, guarantees a team win, finishes a match so allowing you and teammates to leave)? If so you have voluntarily made an adjustment to your actual result of $\frac{1}{2}$ - much bigger than the gap between any suggested expected results functions I've heard of. Your desire to get to the bar before closing time can have a bigger effect on your grade than the choice of expected results function.

And k factors. Might as well be called coefficients of fiddle for all their choice of value seems to have any firm theoretical foundation. All k is is an accelerant, determining how quickly grades change in the light of new data. How quickly should they change? Prove it.

Much less frequently you will hear about the role of grades in the retention of players by the game. In general we would wish players to derive sufficient enjoyment from one year's play that they choose to continue in subsequent years, a simple idea often overlooked by those who seek to add sub-clauses to sub-sections in their league rules in the never-ending battle between legislators and those seeking to thwart their attempts to make sure that the right team wins.

Many people are obsessed by their grades; indeed the funding of the ECF depends on this. This can lead to players sitting down for a game with the objective of defending their grade uppermost in their mind. Mustn't lose. Take no risks. Stick to what you know. This leads naturally to using the same narrow opening repertoire. In time the game seems to lose it's freshness and consequent appeal. Time to find another activity. The mindset and repetition of a small number of openings is not a problem for many people, but I am convinced that some people have effectively been pushed out of the game by their obsession with their grade - and it is clear that any grading system would be equally culpable.

There is a sting in the tail. It is not only obsession with grades that can push one onto a path leading to a loss of satisfaction and falling out of love with the game. Through a heightened feeling of responsibility towards ones teammates, team chess can set you off down the same route.

Sleep well.

A Change of Emphasis

Fischer time controls are noted for their removal of the need for 10.2 claims and their potential associated unpleasantness and feeling of being cheated if the arbiter does not see things your way. Less frequently noted is that such controls also result in a slight change of objective. Instead of trying to win before a guillotine falls, the objective becomes one of reaching a simply won position before you get down to needing the increments to save loss on time. In particular it renders a defence of an inferior position of trying to maintain complexity so that the opponent will sue for peace for fear of loss on time less likely to succeed. Whether or not this change is regarded as a good or bad thing will be down to personal choice, influenced possibly by how often a clock has intervened favourably or unfavourably in ones own attempts for victory or salvation.

Plan B for Funding

Living in Newcastle-u-Lyme can be entertaining. A few years ago a car drew up beside me as I was walking into town, and the passenger wound down their window to ask "Is it far to Durham?". Had they asked for directions I could of course have answered "I wouldn't start from here". A similar reaction can be expected in anyone seriously designing a funding plan for the ECF, for the current cat's cradle of membership types, game fee categories, reductions and exemptions looks more like a system continually tweaked in the face of lobbying by special interest groups than the result of intelligent design.

The basic economic model for the ECF is that it is a body that provides services to the chess community, the profits from which are used to support its own projects. Some will argue that this is wrong - that each activity should be self-funding (don't see that happening anytime soon for national teams) or that the ECF should be a body that arranges sufficient sponsorship that all chess activity is free (we wish!). If some activities are going to consume cash, others have to run at a profit to balance the books.

When it comes to services that large swathes of the chess community value the ECF cupboard is fairly bare. For many players it is only grading that they are prepared to pay for, and extensive debates about funding basically revolve around how best to use grading as a lever to extract cash from the community. Membership schemes may well try to highlight other services, but it is clear that they are still reliant on grading; not only are the only sanctions for failing to join grading related but the schemes are often sold as a single in-lieu-of-game-fee payment. No-one knows how strong the grading lever is or how close we are to the point where leagues would decide to opt out of national grading rather than pay the fees demanded, but it seems reasonable to suppose that the lever will prove stronger if applied in a manner approved by those expected to provide the cash.

Options

Compulsory membership, free services.

All players have to join, in exchange for which services are free. Policing this is the problem, for the ECF would be expecting organisers to act as gatekeepers, turning away or extracting appropriate amounts of cash from non-members attempting to play in their events. Fine if said organisers approve of the scheme, but asking for bad feelings and bad debts if they don't.

Compulsory membership, charge for use of services.

Here the membership fee just allows the member into the shop, they still have to pay for the services. Typically in schemes of this type the fee will be nominal and/or a one off rather than annual one. It allows the organisation to boast a large membership and so legitimately to claim to represent them, and also to exclude from access to its services any undesirables.

Optional Membership, charge for services.

In this option membership would normally provide access to services at a discount. This could be a percentage reduction (50% off game fee for members) or a fixed amount (first £10 of game fee liability waived).

No membership, standard charge for services.

This is the pure game-fee route, with players having to pay every time they play leading to individual contributions being uncapped. Particularly discouraging to the development of secondary events.

Hybrid

Different areas get to chose their own option from some of those above.

Extensive discussion on the ECForum leads to the less than startling conclusion that there is no common ground between the first and fourth of these options (per head and per game charging). Those who truly believe in the value of the ECF will hope that whatever funding scheme is adopted proves up to the task of generating the required sums even if the scheme is one that they would not have chosen personally. The ECF will be putting forward plans for the first option to be adopted, though its supporters do seem to have a might is right attitude that leaves them blind to the possibility of it leading to fracturing with some areas choosing to go down a self-grading route. What to do if the plans are defeated, or attract a sufficiently small majority that saner voices realise that imposing it would not be sensible. Plan B would have to be some sort of hybrid. What would I suggest?

First some comments on the proposed universal membership scheme.

I think the £1/£2 levy on non-member games is good for 3 reasons:

- a) It provides an incentive for local organisers to encourage everyone to join,
- b) Organisations are seen to be playing by the rules rather than turning a blind eye to freeloaders,
- c) Agreement to accepting the levy would be the only pre-condition to a union, county, league or club creating a membership organisation in a mixed membership / non-membership environment.

Secondly I am not convinced that silver membership sits comfortably with the rest of the scheme.

Proponents of membership schemes seem to focus on the benefit of clubs and associations being able to create unlimited playing opportunities for their members without extra charge to the ECF, rather than on capping the contribution of the dedicated congress player.

There are I suspect several people who only play one congress a year - their local one. It might be galling to organise a congress only to find that you get little local support since those who might be expected to give it baulk at the £6 supplement.

Silver membership also implies differential pricing for players from outside ECF territory, though of course congress organisers could still charge a flat rate and treat the additional fees due to the ECF as a congress overhead.

Finally silver membership benefits bite into those for gold, making FIDE event organisers feel they are in some sense being unfairly being targeted.

This leaves my best plan B as set out on the next page. The costs are merely illustrative. The current concept of membership organisations is retained, though modified as implied below. Membership can spread (or shrink) over time as clubs/districts/counties vary their willingness to collect any additional levy due.

Non-FIDE rated congresses pay an event grading charge at a flat rate of say £3 per head. Don't care how many rounds. Don't care whether people claim or are awarded byes, or withdraw early; the charge applies. Easy for the congress organiser to calculate, and the ECF to check. No checking of membership lists or faffing with discounts, the organiser can simply declare on their entry form that the congress will be ECF graded.

Membership structure:

Basic: Available in membership organisation area. £12. Benefits as for proposed Bronze (with respect to games played in MO area events), complete with levies for non-members playing in MO events.

Direct: Available to those outside of MO areas. Benefits - all those listed under proposed gold that relate to FIDE rating and FIDE related events.

Charge £9, being the difference between the proposed silver and gold.

Full: Available in membership organisation area. £21. Literally a combined Basic and Direct membership.

MO recognise each others members.

FIDE-rated events. As these are genuine membership only events, they are also ECF graded at no further charge. ie they do not pay the £3 per head event fee of non-FIDE rated congresses. Might make the membership requirement more palatable for those who organise and play in such events.

Non-MO areas.

Their events are charged an event fee calculated on the number of half games the event is designed to provide, so defaults and withdrawals are still paid for. This saves checking through records to see what games were actually played, the cost can be calculated at the outset. It also means that the unit cost can be slightly less than game-fee to raise the same amount.

Hopefully unit cost somewhere in the region of 60p to 70p, though definitely less than the levy for non-membership games in membership areas.

And finally, Patrons. Players of any membership category or none may become patrons of the ECF for an annual donation of at least a further £30, to be decided by the donor. They get a free yearbook and diary, and their names appear in a list of patrons on the ECF website and possibly in the yearbook. However their membership benefits (if any) are those of their underlying membership category. ie being a patron does not make one a member.

The Sight of Sites

Am I sick of the sight of sites? I have visited everyone of the sites linked to on Chingland, though not necessarily every page of every site, resulting in a fairly wide viewing existence. In general I like what I see, though as my own sites make the style police shudder (and the html police too if they look at the coding), I am hardly the best judge of quality.

As yet there is no Russell group of superior sites maintained by a mutual admiration society of quality web designers, nor a kitemarking system for those satisfying certain requirements. Anything and verything goes. If you've thought of creating a site for your club but been put off by the thought of how amateurish it might look, please think again. A site does not have to be of award winning quality in order to fulfil simple purposes of being an online advert to attract new players or to keep members abreast of your club's activities. And because chess is relatively speaking a niche activity, the search engines will soon give your site a high ranking in response to a relevant search, particularly if there are links to it on other sites. The webmasters of the ECF site and Britweb will need to be contacted to get links to appear there; the same may be true of your local league site. The majority of links on Chingland are ones I have found by surfing or searching, though the link will appear more quickly if you tell me of it.

Despite my general liking for the sites I have found I find certain things niggle. My personal (I stress personal) list of dislikes in no particular order includes

- Undated material. How do I know whether what I am reading is up-to-date? There are plenty of sites out there that have been abandoned (temporarily or permanently), so even part dates - 3rd October - are of little help. Nor is a clever bit of code to display the current date a substitute.
- American dates. For me 5/4 is 5th April not 4th May. Maybe I'm in a minority. To avoid confusion you could always name rather than number months. Alternatively if there are a large number of dates on a page the convention used will be apparent. 2011/05/04 immediately puts my brain into the right date identification mode, but I've found sites where close examination reveals 05/04/2011 to mean May 4th 2011. Yuk.
- Long pages. I find it easier to find what I want on a site with a large number of pages each with a modest amount of content rather than a small number of pages each with a large amount of content.
- "Site under construction, please return soon". My experience is that such notices are particularly beloved by people who never get around to completing their site, so to me reads as a warning of a site liable to abandoned in its current state. I can understand wanting to create the full layout, complete with internal links, for your site first, with content to follow, but not wanting empty pages. Simply comment out the internal links until the relevant page is ready to go live.
- Javascript only navigation. Several friends have reported that their employers network only allows web browsing with javascript disabled, the employers fear being that the javascript might be a security risk. Whether or not the employers fears are justified is irrelevant, if your site uses javascript only navigation you risk people being stuck on your home page. It is not unusual to find javascript heavy sites also having ordinary html links discretely placed in the small print at the bottom of the page so that they do not destroy the visual impression of the site.
- Browser specific code. No, I do not think your site is so wonderful that I will download / fire up a particular browser. I don't expect all sites to work with some of the older browsers I insist on using from time to time, but if I can't get in with Firefox I'm not interested. You may be wowed by your ability to use the most up-to-date technology, I think you're being unfriendly. Needless to say this tends to be a Microsoft problem, with their web-authoring software producing code that can only be read by Explorer. One of the early versions of Frontpage was guilty of this, though the problem seemed to disappear for a few years. Unfortunately there now seems to be a new filetype that only Explorer will handle. I'm not expert enough to know whether this is a case of Microsoft trying to impose their own standards on the net, or if they are early adopters of an agreed standard, though messages that 'you will need to use Internet Explorer to view this page' hint at the former. The page does not get viewed. If you are fearful that your chosen web-authoring package produces browser specific code, view your site in at least two browsers!

Key to the Links

- A An actively maintained site.
- Z Dozing. Designed to be actively maintained, but not updated for a few months the last time I checked.
- D Dormant. Designed to be actively maintained, but no updates for a considerable time. Some probably deserve an E for extinct.
- B Browser dependent. Currently usually means that the site requires javascript or flash for navigation, but from time to time also denotes site that accidentally contains other code that may prevent some browsers from viewing the site.
- U Unfriendly. Designed not to work with some browsers - warning notices on the site makes it clear this is not accidental.
- P A static site designed to give the organisation a presence on the web. P+ indicates some non-static content, but not enough in my opinion to warrant an A label.
- L A listing on some other site not controlled by the organisation. Most clubs are listed on their league sites, usually I have not included these listings in the links.

Berkshire, Buckinghamshire, Oxfordshire and Hampshire play in all three divisions of the Chiltern League - U200, U150, U125.

Northumberland, Durham, Cleveland, Merseyside, Cheshire & North Wales, Herefordshire, Northamptonshire and Wiltshire did not compete in intercounty events.

From time to time people try to come up with ways of altering the inter-counties events so as to attract more entries. I am not a fan of this format as it seems to generate more than its fair share of defaults and disputes, and I prefer to attend a congress if I'm available for weekend chess. However there are clearly several people who are attracted by the one game a day format and who do not feel that most the time all they are involved in is an exercise in fulfilling a fixture.

Even though not all entrants intend to take up places in the national stages should they qualify, the numbers are viable. Small changes by their nature would have little effect on the size of the field, large ones would alter the nature of the events. It is human nature that many people's view of the desirability of entering a competition is affected by how well they would anticipate doing. Many of the blanks in the table on the previous page represent counties that lack the strength in depth to expect to be competitive.

I doubt that shrinking teams to 12 players would be beneficial - I suspect not enough extra teams would be attracted to balance the four player per team loss. Halving the size to eight so that current entrants could field two teams would not only dilute the feeling of county representation but would lead to only one team being entered by many current entrants on the basis that their second team could not compete with their first, these complaints of course coming from people who decry the current lack of entries from weaker counties that they could duff up.

Forcing larger counties to split on some geographical basis is only likely to be attractive to those outside them, whilst counties are sufficiently jealous of their independence that they are unlikely to countenance mergers.

Fide rating isn't the irresistible attraction that its advocates suggest, and whilst such rating might be welcomed by many of the current participants, it is unlikely to pull in teams of new entries from those who have been able to resist the other charms of intercounty play.

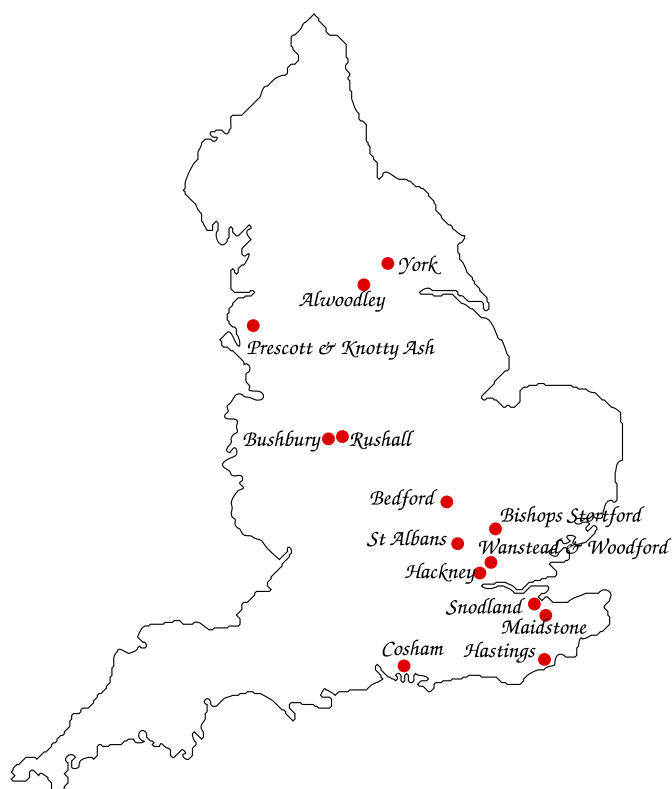
If the NCCU feels that Yorkshire and Lancashire are too dominant within their area they could try to negotiate the introduction of a special rule that only one of these could qualify in each section for the national stages, but that is the NCCU's business, not something to be imposed by outside.

By all means keep an eye on numbers and consider any new ideas as they arise, but be careful that any improvements don't simply bring in new faces at the cost of those currently involved.

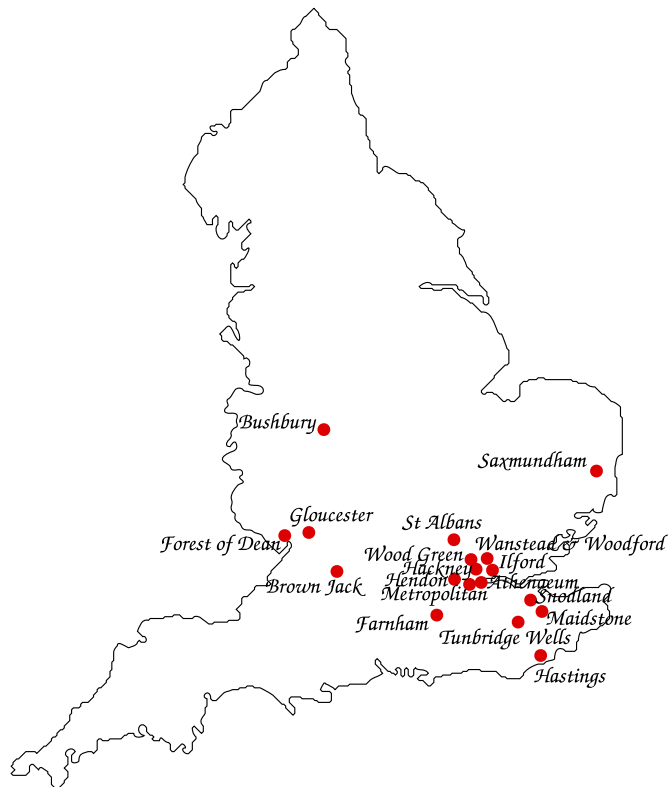
National Club



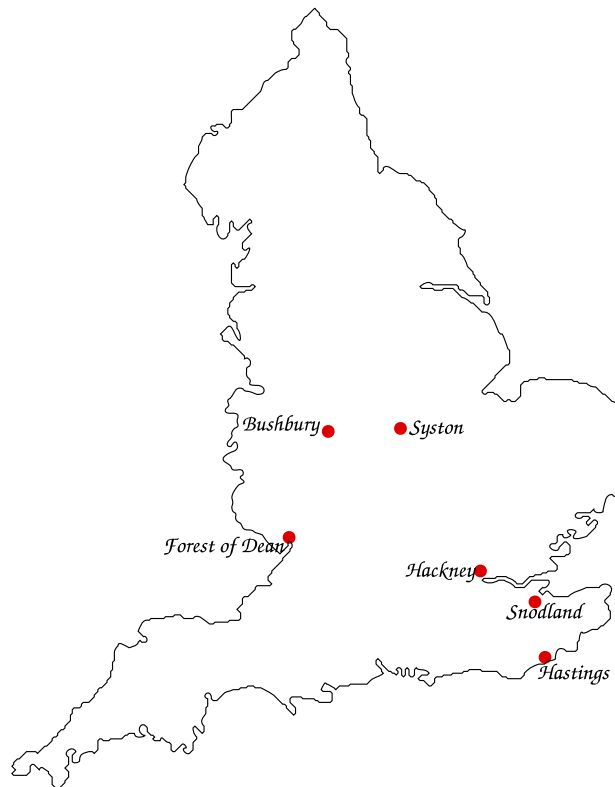
Open: 3 entries, winners Wood Green

How much further does the number of entries have to shrink before the ECF realise that this set of competitions needs to be ditched? The problem is not so much that a national body should not be concerning itself with such modestly supported competitions but that the ECF are willing to trot out running the National Club as one of the things it does to justify its existence. Without the National Club the ECF might feel obliged/inclined to create a different set of events, with wider appeal, that would do more to create goodwill towards it. Unfortunately, despite the fact that the one thing that chess players are known to do is play chess, the ECF seems disinclined to woo the chess community by getting into event organisation.

The Open section of the National Club has clearly lost out to the 4NCL despite having first mover advantage as a national team competition. Why?

- Format

The National Club is a knock-out, the 4NCL all play throughout, so you get a worthwhile return for setting up a team, and you know exactly the commitment you are making.

- Organisation

In the National Club captains have to arrange venues, dates and equipment themselves. The 4NCL sorts all this out for you, and tells you in advance about venues and dates. With all the logistics being sorted by captains the ECF don't so much organise the National Club as provide someone to oversee it.

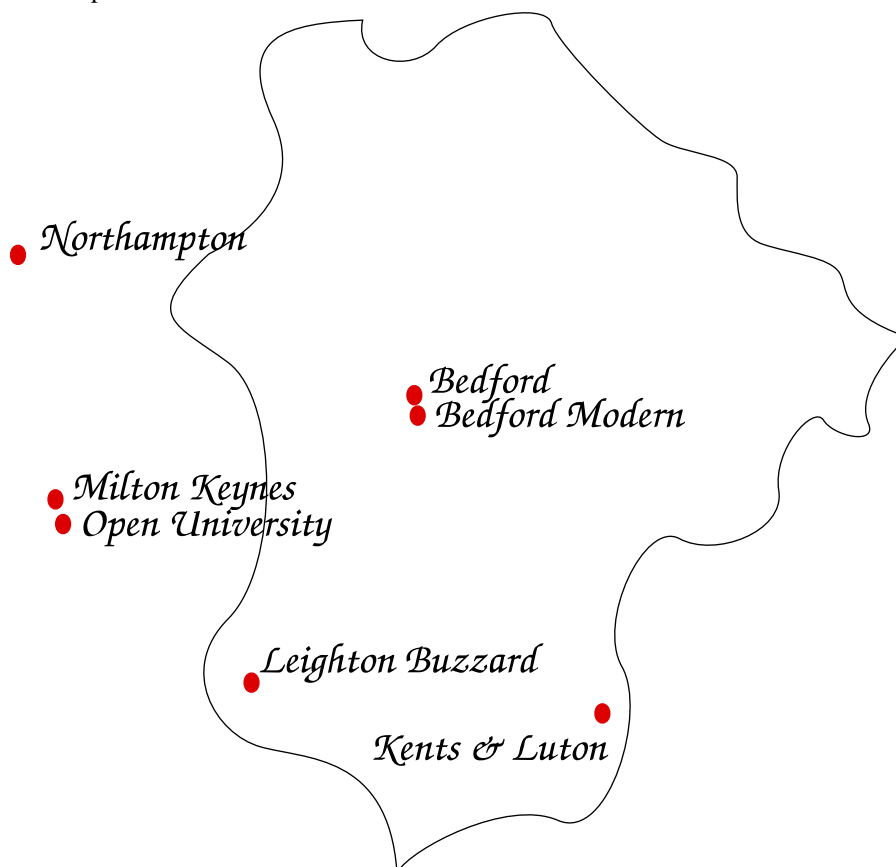
- Bona Fides

The 4NCL's "forget the bit about bona fides" attitude towards team formation makes it easier to form teams, yet doesn't seem to have a detrimental effect on the league's status.

I don't include Fide-rating of results simply because I don't believe that being Fide-rated would have enabled the National Club to put up a significantly greater fight against the 4NCL.

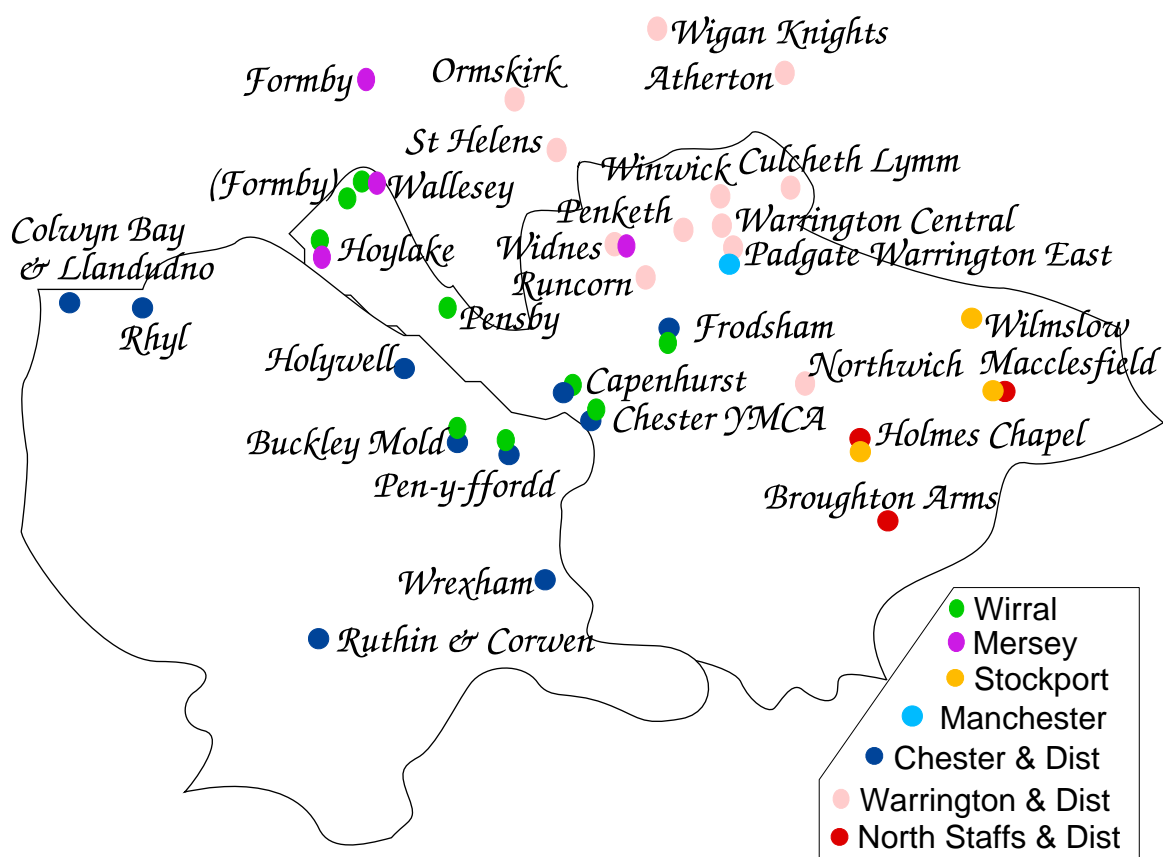

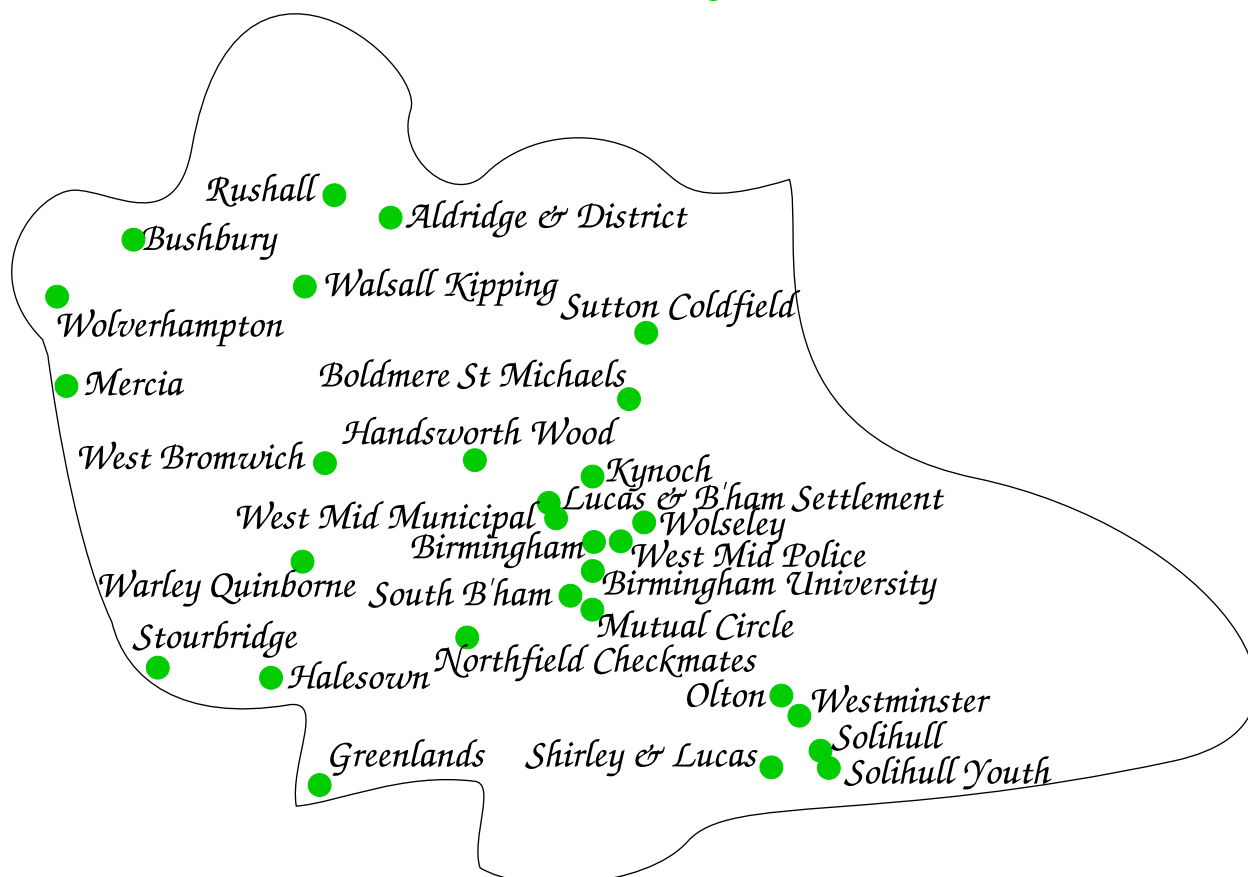
